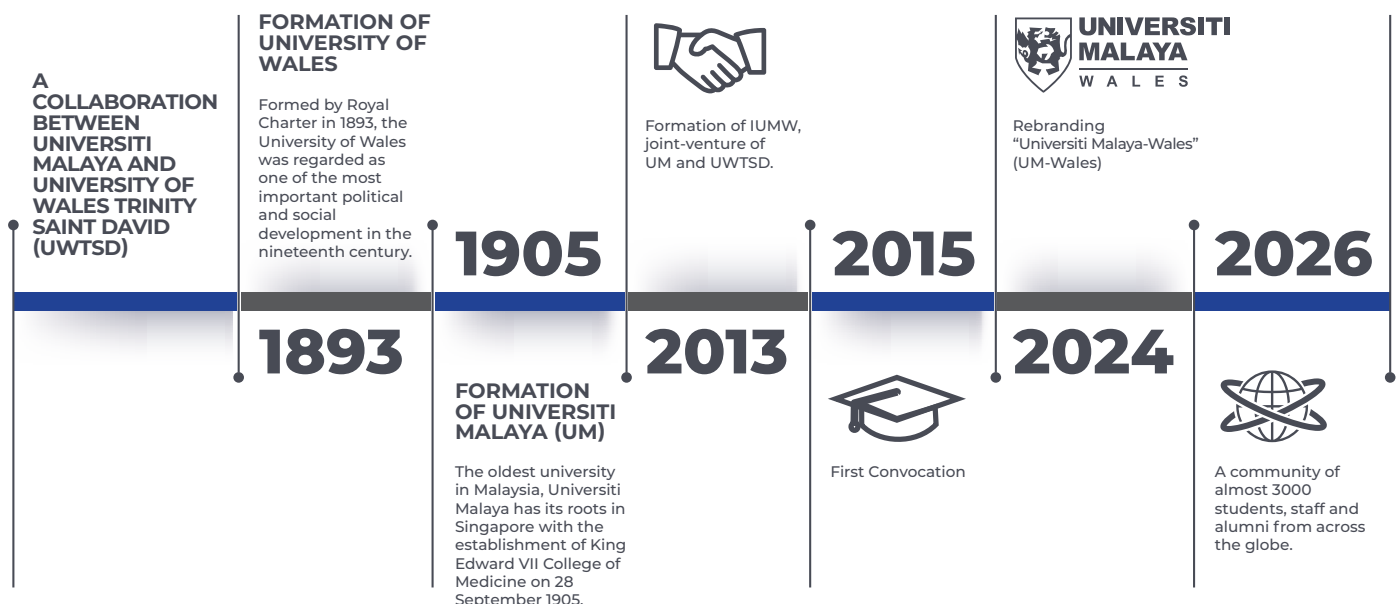

ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

- Proof of English proficiency certification will be required (including Dual Awards students, and students planning to study at UWSTD for the mobility programme), eg IELTS, MUET, TOEFL. See the website for the minimum qualifying score.
- * English language requirements can be waived if the international student EITHER comes from a country that uses English as the official language.
- * Students using academic qualifications from Higher Education Provider (HEP) use English as the medium of instruction and wish to apply for a higher level of study can be exempted.

- * The fee for international students excludes the EMGS visa application fee of RM2,700.

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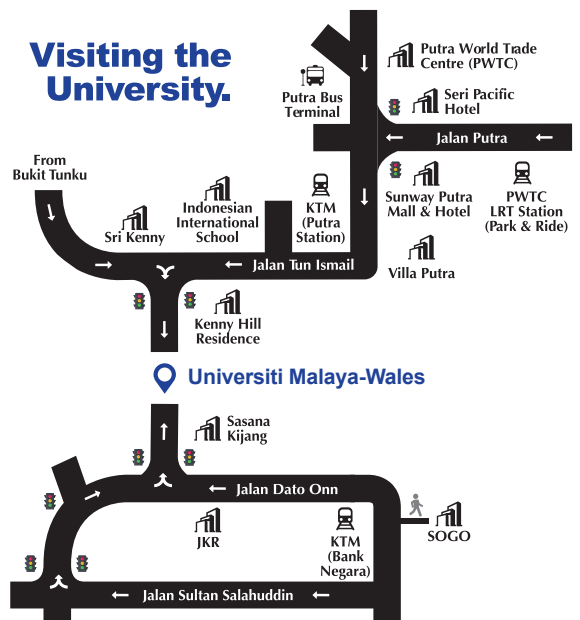
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
